

## Iran's Central Banker is a Sanctioned Terrorist

As the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) convenes in Paris from June 24 thru June 29, we urge members to blacklist Iran and re-impose effective countermeasures to stymie the Islamic Republic's continued sponsorship of terrorism.

The fact that Valiollah Seif, the governor of the Central Bank of Iran, has recently been sanctioned as a specially designated global terrorist by the United States as a result of his funneling money to Hezbollah on behalf of the Iranian government is the latest reminder that Tehran continues to be the world's leading state sponsor of terrorism.
