Subject: Formal Request for Removal of Sea Rock from the UANI List

Dear Sir,

We respectfully submit this appeal regarding the listing of the vessel *Sea Rock* in [The Ghost Armada: The List Scrapped Violators](#) published on your website.

It has come to our attention that the vessel was reported on the list as of **July 31, 2022**. At that time, however, *Sea Rock* was not under the ownership, management, or operational control of our company.

Accordingly, we believe the current inclusion of the vessel on the UANI list is not a fair reflection of its present status and trading practices.

We would like to clarify the following for your kind consideration:

1. Change of Ownership and Authority

- The vessel *Sea Rock* was officially transferred to our ownership and management under BOS on **September 12, 2023**.
- Since that date, all operations of the vessel have been conducted strictly under recognized legal authority and in accordance with international maritime conventions.

2. Compliance with International Regulations

- Since assuming ownership, we have ensured the vessel operates only within lawful trading routes and jurisdictions.
- The vessel has not engaged in any trade or activities with sanctioned regions, entities, or authorities.
- Full compliance with IMO, Flag State, and Class requirements is always maintained.

3. Supporting Documentation

- For verification, we have attached copies of the **Ship Registry Certificate** and **Bill of Sale**, confirming the legitimate transfer of ownership and current authority.
- Additional compliance records can be provided upon request.

Considering the above, we kindly request **the removal of Sea Rock from the UANI list**. This will ensure that the vessel's present ownership and operational record are correctly represented and not associated with past activities prior to our management.

We highly appreciate your understanding, guidance, and support in this matter and remain at your disposal should you require further information or documentation.
